5. Why are the political institutions stronger in India and weaker in Pakistan. Substantiate your viewpoint with strong arguments.
6. Do you agree with the view that Mustafa Kamal Pasha's political philosophy provided an ideological foundation and stability to the Turkish political system.
7. What are the striking points of contrast of constitutions of Pakistan and India.
